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PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE



OBSERVATION #1 – Agreements And Environmental

Processing

- In general LPA's do not have a good understanding of federal requirements for Phase I processing.
- Approvals take too much time and expense to complete



RECOMMENDATION #1

- Develop flowcharts and set milestones
- Expand Phase I training
- Continue training of BLRS staff
- Coordinate all recommendations into the current BLRS Manual re-write

RESOLUTIONS #1

- Provided Training
- * BLRS Manual re-write



OBSERVATION #2 - Agreements

Inefficiencies exist in IDOT's processing of agreements



RECOMMENDATION #2

- Allow early federal authorization
- Eliminate redundant reviews of engineering agreements
- Reduce errors in funding agreements
- Share and implement best practices

RESOLUTIONS #2

- Early federal authorization implemented
- * Redundant review eliminated
- Training conducted

OBSERVATION #3 – Agreements And Environmental Processing

Unknown status of agreements and environmental clearances in the Central Office



RECOMMENDATION #3

- Modification of the Central Office MFT tracking system.
- Share District best practices
- Grant LPA's access to tracking systems

RESOLUTIONS #3

Shared best practices



OBSERVATION #4 – Environmental Processing

Preliminary Environmental Site Assessments (PESA) for projects impacting state ROW take a minimum of 6 months to process

RECOMMENDATION #4

- Submit Environmental Survey Request early
- Create flowcharts
- Review BLRS special waste policy
- Evaluate BDE procedure

RESOLUTIONS #4

In progress



OBSERVATION #5 – Environmental Processing

LPA's indicated some lack of clarity of processing requirements for the CE1, CE2, EA, and EIS classifications

RECOMMENDATION #5

- Provide Phase I training for LPA's
- Inform LPA's of changes to Categorical Exclusions
- Coordination Meetings

RESOLUTIONS #5

- Training
- Programmatic Agreement for CE's
- Coordination Meetings

OBSERVATION #6 - Environmental Processing

LPA's indicated too much design (Phase II work) is required for Project Development Reports

RECOMMENDATION #6

- Process more projects as Group I CE
- Review/modify BLRS Manual

RESOLUTIONS #6

- * Revised Forms
- IDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement for Categorical Exclusions
- Manual Update

BEST PRACTICES

- Training
- Early submittal of Environmental Survey Requests



BEST PRACTICES

- Bi-Monthly Coordination meetings keep projects active and progressing with agency collaboration
- Project initiation meetings were beneficial in getting projects started efficiently
- District 1 BLRS Project Information (PPI) form
- Several Districts had project tracking systems
